11/0862/DK	Ecological Survey Assessment prepared by Worcestershire Wildlife Consultancy was received 30.11.2011 and concludes as follows:  On the day of the survey assessment there was no positive evidence that bats are presently (or previously) using the flat-roofed buildings adjacent to Housman Hall. Therefore, based on the available evidence, there are no obvious and immediate implications with regard to bats under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended) or the Conservation of Habitats and Species Regulations 2010. As a result no
	further dedicated surveys are recommended on this part of the building.
