2/07 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

No declarations of interest were made.

3/07 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The Minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 20th September 2006 were submitted.

4/07 <u>DECISIONS OF THE ADJUDICATION PANEL</u>

The Committee considered the decisions which had recently been taken by the Adjudication Panel on a range of cases where Councillors had breached the Code of Conduct. The report detailed the decisions taken by the Panel in each case.

5/07 **LOCAL GOVERNMENT WHITE PAPER**

The Committee was informed of proposals contained in the government white paper, entitled "Strong and Prosperous Communities", for changes to the current standards regime. The principal changes were a more locally-based standards regime with "filtering" of complaints being carried out by Monitoring Officers rather than the Standards Board for England; a more strategic role for the Standards Board; a clearer, simpler and more proportionate code of conduct for members; and a new code of conduct for employees.

6/07 HIGH COURT DECISION REGARDING THE CODE OF CONDUCT

The Committee considered details of the outcome of the decision of the High Court in the case of Ken Livingstone -v- The Adjudication Panel for England. The Court held that where a councillor did something in an entirely private capacity, where his conduct has nothing to do with his position as a councillor, he will not be covered by the Code and no action can be taken against that councillor under the Code.
