#### 13/14 HACKNEY CARRIAGE AND PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DRIVER'S LICENCE - REVIEW

At the invitation of the Chairman, the licensed driver put forward his case again and answered a number of questions from Members of the Sub-Committee. The licensed driver expressed his concern that the witness had decided not to attend the Sub-Committee meeting.

The Sub-Committee then adjourned to consider its decision. Upon its return it was

**<u>RESOLVED</u>** that a warning be issued to the licensed driver in light of the information received.
