### 32/18 APPLICATION FOR A HACKNEY CARRIAGE VEHICLE LICENCE

The Sub-Committee considered an application made for exemption to the Council's Hackney Carriage Vehicle Licence Policy that restricted vehicles being licensed as a Hackney Carriage Vehicle in the District.

The Technical Officer (Licensing), Worcestershire Regulatory Services (WRS) outlined the details of the application, together with the reasons why the application had been brought before the Sub-Committee, detailing page 21 (g) of the Council's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Handbook; which stated that "Vehicles being licensed as a Hackney Carriage for the first time must be no more than 7 years older than the date of first registration when the application was made".

At the invitation of the Chairman, the applicant put forward his case in support of his application and answered a number of questions from Members of the Sub-Committee.

The Sub-Committee then adjourned to consider its decision. Upon its return it was:-

**<u>RESOLVED</u>** that the application be granted.

#### 33/18 APPLICATION FOR A HACKNEY CARRIAGE VEHICLE LICENCE

The Sub-Committee considered an application for the grant of a licence to use a vehicle as a Hackney Carriage that fell outside of the Council's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Handbook which restricted vehicles in the District with tinted windows that conceal the identity of passengers inside the vehicle.

The Technical Officer (Licensing), Worcestershire Regulatory Services (WRS) outlined the details of the application together with the reasons why the application had been brought before the Sub-Committee, detailing page 21 (k) of the Council's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Handbook.

At the invitation of the Chairman, the applicant and his representative put forward his case in support of his application; whereby they both answered a number of questions from Members of the Sub-Committee and the Council's Legal Advisor.

Sub-Committee Members inspected the vehicle to determine the level of tint on the windows of the vehicle.

The Sub-Committee then adjourned to consider its decision, upon its return it was:

**RESOLVED** that the application be refused.
