#### 6/08 ANNUAL POLLING STATION REVIEW

The Committee considered a report which detailed the annual review of polling stations within the District, in pursuance of the Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006.

The Committee voiced their concern about the type and size of portable building units used as polling stations as a result of feedback from previous elections. In addition, Members expressed a wish for improved accessibility

for disabled persons and wheelchair users into polling station premises used at elections.

#### **RESOLVED**

- (a) that the review of polling districts and polling places, as detailed in Appendix 1 to the report, be approved and adopted; and
- (b) that officers be requested to continually monitor the location of, and access arrangements for, polling stations used at elections within the District.

#### 1. SUMMARY

1.1 To undertake an annual review of all Polling Districts and Polling Places within the District of Bromsgrove in compliance with The Review of Polling Districts & Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006.

#### 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 That the review of polling districts and places shown at Appendix 1 be approved and adopted.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Electoral Administration Act 2006 requires all local authorities in England and Wales to undertake a full review of Polling Districts and Polling Places every 4 years. An annual review of polling places is considered good practise.
- 3.2 In undertaking the review, the Council must seek to ensure that all electors have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances, and have regard to the needs of electors who are disabled.
- 3.3 This review is not concerned with alterations to Ward boundaries, only Polling Districts and the situation of polling stations.
- 3.4 Consultation has been sought from District and County Council Members, Parish Councillors and Parish Clerks.

#### 4. FINDINGS

4.1 All polling places and polling stations within the District have been evaluated in terms of suitability and accessibility. The law says that facilities for voting must be reasonable and practicable. What this means in practice is a matter of judgement, but there is certainly no duty on the Council to make an unreasonably high level of provision, or to provide facilities in locations where it is impracticable to do so.

#### Representations Received

- 4.2 A request has been received from Bentley Pauncefoot Parish Council to consider returning to Bentley Village Hall following recent improvements.
- 4.3 A request has been received from Blackwell Methodist Church Hall to consider an alternative venue.

# 5. REVISIONS RECOMMENDED

- 5.1 Electors for the Bentley Pauncefoot Polling District (TAA) currently vote at the Church Hall at Tardebigge, which involves some distance to travel. Bentley Village Hall has recently been upgraded to meet the Disabilities Act recommendations with a suitable ramped access leading to double doors and the interior has been completely refurbished to a high standard for use as polling station.
- 5.2 Electors for Burcot Polling District (LTA), Linthurst Polling District (LTB) and the Shepley Polling District (LTC) currently vote at the Methodist Church Hall, Green Hill, Blackwell. An alternative location for a polling station has been has been located at The Wheel, St Catherine's Church, Blackwell. This room is in the centre of the village and fully accessible under the Disabilities Act recommendations; it is of a high standard and has all suitable facilities for use as a polling station.

## 6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

6.1 There will be a cost for rent and employment of election staff for the additional polling station at Bentley.

#### 7. LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

7.1. In accordance with the requirements of section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

#### 1. SUMMARY

1.1 To report a revision of codes used to represent the polling districts in the Register of Electors.

#### 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 That the list of polling district codes attached at Appendix 1 be approved.

3.1 A revision of polling district codes represents the wards using the first two digits and the particular polling district with the third digit was conducted in 2008. Following the implementation of shared Electoral Services some codes are duplicated and it would be less confusing if the codes for Charford Ward and Marlbrook Ward were altered.
