You were so helpful spending time explaining to me last Thursday the difficulties and intricacies of Tree Preservation Orders.

I am particularly concerned about the trees - oak, horse chestnut and ash - along the skyline on land adjacent to the Crown Public House on the Stourbridge Road, Catshill. Apart from their visual impact for many houses in lower Catshill, they do lessen the noise from the motorway. I understand there is a Confirmed Order on the entire wooded area, but it is especially the sky line trees I am concerned for.

The land was auctioned on 23rd September by Bigwood, guide price £30,000.

Is each case allocated a number, so that it would be easier to be specific when making an enquiry about progress? How many trees could one person nominate for a Preservation Order?

I realise you must be very busy, but I hope you would not object if I contacted you from time to time about these trees.
