88 Birmingham Road, Bromsgrove - Application for Premises License Ref: CVE/28715/68/RPB

With reference to the above application, as an immediate neighbour of the site I strongly object to the application to sell alcohol 24-hours a day 7-days a week from the proposed petrol station. Not only do I have to put up with the existing noise from the 2 a.m. "revellers" making their way out of town at the weekend; this application will now give them an additional excuse to buy more alcohol and loiter on street around the site. I can put up with the adjacent Hop Pole PH as that is closed by midnight and causes no problems.

There is no need for a petrol station to be selling alcohol AT ALL, never mind 24-hours a day – what kind of drink/drive message does that send out?

Furthermore, please explain exactly what "the provision of late-night refreshment daily between the hours of 00:00 and 05:00 and 23:00 to 24:00" actually means; apart from it being a long-winded way of saying 23:00 to 05:00!
