RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COUNCIL

1. TOILETS IN BROMSGROVE CEMETERY AND SANDERS PARK

The Cabinet has considered a report on the latest position regarding the previous decision to refurbish the existing toilets in Bromsgrove Cemetery.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED

- (a) that the toilets within Bromsgrove Cemetery be closed and demolished at a cost of approximately £5,000; and
- (b) that the uncommitted balance of the capital budget previously allocated to the refurbishment of the Cemetery toilets (approximately £18,000) be transferred to fund the improvements of the toilets in Sanders Park.

2. MEMBERSHIP OF IMPROVEMENT AND EFFICIENCY SOCIAL ENTERPRISE

The Cabinet has considered a report on a proposal that the Council becomes a member of the Improvement and Efficiency Social Enterprise (iESE).

Clarification was given that the Council's representative would not have Director status within iESE; the correct position was that the Council through its representative would be a member with voting rights at the Annual General Meeting.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED

That a Bromsgrove District Councillor be nominated as Member and/or Voting Delegate of iESE Limited.

3. BROMSGROVE TOWN CENTRE – PUBLIC REALM IMPROVEMENTS

The Cabinet has considered a report in relation to the funding arrangements for the improvements to the Public Realm in the High Street and Worcester Road, Bromsgrove.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED

- (a) that the Capital Programme 2013/2014 be revised to £1,150,000 to reflect the element of the project to be funded by Bromsgrove District Council from current capital receipts available; and
- (b) that £350,000 be included in the Capital Programme 2014/2015 to reflect the cost to the District Council of the works to the Public Realm in Worcester Road to be funded from future capital receipts.
