22:30 - Arrived on site.

Loud noise of music and revellers voices clearly audible. Doors and windows largely closed, however entry door in centre of frontage was being used for access/egress regularly and this resulted in considerable noise breakout.

It was a double door arrangement from what I could see, but was being made ineffectual by both doors being open at the same time on regular occasions. There appeared to be a disco and recorded/live music taking place downstairs and appeared to be an event on upstairs.

Summary – clear case for further investigation from both Licencing and Statutory nuisance grounds.

23:35 – Went to front of premises – due to onset of rain the front patio area was now clear of people, however some people smoking were stood in the aforementioned doorway, and one or both of the doors were always open.

Checked rear beer garden – not in use. There was a live band on downstairs, Very loud when a door was opened, and still clearly audible when doors were closed. Side entrance door was also open.

00:15 – Live and recorded music stopped. Departed site.
