<b>Aim of Project:</b>	To provide the school and local community with access to an area that can be line marked for multi-use sports such as football, tennis, netball and basketball which will allow kindergarten and school children to benefit from this space during the school day and the local community to benefit in the evening, at weekends and during school holidays.
