Aim of Project:	To refurbish the kitchen so that it can be used by the young people of 6 th Bromsgrove as a safer option to using camping equipment. This will also complete the refurbishment of the hut which will allow us to rent out the hut more. The hut has been well received by the Church group who has been using it whilst their usual meeting place is being renovated, and we would anticipate being able to offer the building to other community groups.
