We have lived next door to the club for the past three years, and would like to state our thoughts on this matter.


When we originally moved in, we were fully aware of the club's location, and also from time to time music would be played, especially over the weekends, it is after all a social club. But it was our choice to live next door.

The club has been at the heart of Lickey End for many years, and serves as the main social hub for the area.
