We wish to add further objections to this letter which has already been submitted. We would also request that you take into account two points that we forgot to include in our original letter of objection to a license being granted for No. 1 Bear Hill.

As our property building as No. 1 and the license request that music be part of the application, to a late hour i.e. 11.00pm, we are concerned that due to the age of the building, we will be disturbed by sound that is known to travel through solid substances, not only the brickwork but also the structural timber beams that run through Bear Hill and connect to the timber beams in our part of the building. These beams are between 10" and 11" square so would conduct sounds very well. (Note please that water authorities still use wooden poles to detect water leaks.)

Our second point of objection is that an outside smoking area is approx 25' from the rear bedroom window of our property, this room is used, why is it deemed acceptable for a smoking area to be sited so close to residential accommodation.
