

Bromsgrove District Council Development Management Response:

The Development Management Team at Bromsgrove District Council hereby **OBJECTS** to the Street Trading Application at Stoney Lane Farm, Stoney Lane, Bromsgrove, B60 1LZ (referred to as Longlands: this is the name of the farmhouse. The hut is located outside a building associated with Stoney Lane Farm. Longlands and Stoney Lane Farm are both owned by the applicant).
