I am objecting to the extension in opening hours of "Tasty Chicken" of 160 New Road, Rubery B45 on the following grounds...

- 1. Rubery does not need a takeaway open at 2am. There are no clubs or pubs around it that are open, i.e. Tasty Chicken is in a village... not 'Broad Street, Birmingham.
- 2. It will lead to an increase in 'yob culture.' (The Shop itself has already broken its rule of trade, by opening as late as 02.45am on a Saturday Night/Sunday morning, leading to noise and anti social behaviour at this hour. This was reported to BDC, and as a result Tasty Chicken has now applied for its extension.) This will affect the ability to police, and will put an even bigger strain on the resource of this service.
- 3. There will be an increase in litter, leading to other environmental issues, such as an increase in rats.
- 4. Tasty Chicken is essentially only yards from residential areas, St. Chads Road, and noise pollution coming from it, after 11pm is wholly unacceptable... and as mentioned in (2) when it is open as late as 02.45am it is a fact that there is noise and anti social behaviour coming from around it.
