We would like to object to the above proposal for a street trader at Ryefields Road, Stoke Prior. We did not get the chance to object when this trader just appeared during lockdown, I understand that people needed to trade to make an income during lockdown and were sympathetic as we had lost our ability to work.

We do not wish this to become a permanent fixture even though it says one day only, it causes an increase in traffic to the road which is already exasperated with extra traffic from the new housing estate and local industrial units to the shops/school. There are constant problems with parking especially for those living in Prior Avenue when everyone returns from work and looks for parking spaces. This on top of the cars visiting the local store which will not be able to park on shop frontage so will then park across adjacent dropped curbs, an issue we as residents have to deal with daily.

We live XXXXXX the proposed site. Since the partial lifting of lockdown people have returned to their cars and will not be walking to pick up food but driving, as we have seen this increase daily. Cars are left with engines running polluting the air, outside the shop and school, parking on pavements and grass areas.
