<p>Emergencies.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To act in accordance with the delegated procedures set out in the Emergency Plan.</li> <li>2. To enable Officers to undertake appropriate communications activity during an emergency without recourse to members, should the situation require an immediate response.</li> <li>3. To incur expenditure essential to meet any immediate needs created by an emergency in accordance with the Financial Regulations.</li> </ol>	<p>1. - 3. Cabinet / Leader.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Chief Executive, Executive Directors, Deputy Chief Executive , Executive Director &amp; Heads of Service.</li> <li>2. Chief Executive, Deputy Chief Executive, Executive Director.</li> <li>3. Heads of Service with agreement of the Cabinet/ Leader or, if the Cabinet/ Leader is unavailable and in cases of extreme emergency only, the relevant Portfolio Holder.</li> </ol>
