Disturbance from the pub has not been great until recently. The previous landlord held disco nights with very loud music occasionally (usually bank holidays).

This has now increased to at least once a week.

The music is loud with persistent bass-beat (which makes it difficult to even watch TV) and the most annoying element of this is that there's total disregard for any of the neighbours – all the windows and doors are kept wide open and there's obviously no sound-proofing. When the pub empties there is then loud, aggressive behaviour and the usual foul language which goes on into the early hours.

I am writing with respect to the late night entertainment taking place at the Duke of York public house situated at 83 Broad Street Sidemoor Bromsgrove.




