The purpose of this application is to vary the Licence :-

1. To extend the licensed area to cover the proposed roof terrace for existing licensable activities and existing hours and further, to approve minor seating layout changes as identified on the plans deposited with the Licensing Authority.
2. To advance the commencement hour Monday – Sunday to 08.00 for all existing licensable activities with a similar adjustment to the opening hour.
3. To extend the licensing hours by 1 hour on the commencement of British Summertime to replace the hour lost. As such, the relevant boxes b,c, e, f, g, i, j, l and m have been ticked to reflect the request to extend the non-standard time.

As a condition on this Licence (annexure 2 condition 11) the approved drawing number is cited. It would be proposed that this would be updated with the new plan as deposited with the Licensing Authority.

It is anticipated that the primary offering of the site will be non-licensable activities at the earlier hour from 08.00 such as tea's, coffee's and breakfasts. The variation to include licensable activities is to permit maximum flexibility.

The purpose of the application is to improve facilities at the Rousler. In that the premises presently operate without difficulty and are subject to existing conditions which promote the licensing objectives, it is not anticipated that the changes will adversely affect those licensing objectives. The operating statement has been completed on that basis.


